

MBAA Northern California 2010 Scholarship Application

In keeping with the bylaws of the MBAA the members of District Northern California have chosen to set up a scholarship fund to provide funds to members to pursue endeavors for the general benefit of brewing. The funds for these scholarships come from annual dues and are a reinvestment in the future of our members and industry alike. In the past recipients have used their awards for a variety of courses, training, conferences or even self learning.

Applications will only be accepted from MBAA district Northern California members in good standing or from individuals who have applied for membership with payment at the time the scholarship application is submitted. Applications are available online at www.mbaa.com.

You must state the specific reason you are seeking funds.

If awarded all payments will be in the form of reimbursements and proof of completion will be required.

If awarded a scholarship, be prepared to explain to membership what it is you gained from the proceeds of your scholarship money. This could either be in person or by letter.

Any misrepresentation on an application will disqualify applicant.

Please answer all of the following questions for review by the scholarship committee.

Answers are best if short and complete.

1. Date of application
2. Name of applicant
3. Current MBAA member or current application with payment? If so, which chapter, and how long?
4. Home and permanent address (if different) including phone and email
5. Education history from high school completion to present, including fields of study
6. Scholarships applied for or received
7. Intended future education, if any
8. Employment in past 3 years, including employers, dates and duties
9. Experience/employment related to malting and brewing
10. Volunteer and extracurricular activities worthy of note
11. Explain why you are interested in the field of brewing and the path that got you to where you are.
12. Describe your career/educational aspirations
13. Describe what **specific expense including cost**, you want a scholarship for and how this is relevant to your career
14. List one current MBAA member who endorses you as an appropriate person to receive a NCMBAA scholarship
15. List two personal references who understand your commitment to this industry, including name, address, and phone or email
