- Regarding the inquiry into the nature of the district's investments at the last meeting, Bill Ladish noted that we have about \$5,700 in money market, but the rest is in a floating rate fund a high return but high risk investment. He suggested we may want to go back to FDIC insured investments for the majority of our savings.
- It was suggested that Bill Ladish may be a candidate for replacing Joe Thorner as district finance chair this was tabled for new business.
- Condolences were noted by Tom V. for the following members who passed away since the last meeting: Greg Beeson and Larry Murkuski.

Membership Report (Gretchen Kalav):

- Three new members were gained during March and April 2011
- Two new members were in attendance: Heiko Grimm of Norit Haffmanns, Inc. and Kaitlyn Lane of Stevens Point Brewing Co.

Karl Ockert presented the Beer Steward Program to the board - we've already had 500 people in the program and it has already paid for itself!
Next program is immediately before/in conjunction with the conference in Minneapolis.
