The application deadline for each course scholarship is as follows.

- Brewery Engineering and Utilities – June 1st
- Brewing and Malting Science – August 1st
- Brewery Packaging Technology – February 1st

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Two years of professional brewing or allied trade experience
- Two years consecutive and current membership to MBAA District Philadelphia.

The following must be included with this application:

- Professional Résumé
- Letters of endorsement from two current members in good standing with MBAA District Philadelphia.
- Contact information for the above mentioned endorsees
- A short narrative essay addressing the following
 - Your experience in the brewing industry
 - How you came to be involved/interested in brewing
 - Your brewing career goals
 - How this scholarship can help you to accomplish these goals
 - Your special achievements, honors, or recognitions relevant to this scholarship (if any)

The application and additional required information should be submitted to MBAAPhiladelphiaScholarship@gmail.com

Notes:

- Awarding of the scholarship may be made public information, and awardees should agree to the use of their name attached to the award if they are selected.
- Applications will be screened by the scholarship committee, and a winner chosen based on:
 - District membership
 - Financial need
 - Individuals who have chosen beer as a career with precedence given to those employed by breweries
 - Individuals who are likely to teach others
- Decisions will be by vote of a simple majority and all decisions will be final. Committee members shall be ineligible to vote regarding scholarships for themselves or members of their families.
- Proof will be confirmed by the District that winners are in good standing with two year tenure in the MBAA
- Applicants must be committed to financing all other ancillary costs, including transportation, involved with the course.
- Any misrepresentation on an application or supporting documentation will disqualify the applicant from receiving scholarship funds
- Scholarship will be marketed through the MBAA website, district email list, and the BA forum.
