

Master Brewer's Association of the Americas District Philadelphia Scholarship

MBAA's mission is to provide technical and practical knowledge that assists the brewing industry to continuously improve product, procedures, and processes from raw materials through consumption by providing professional development, education and support, Identifying and communicating technical information and innovation, providing awareness of emerging issues. As part of that mission, District Philadelphia has established a biannual scholarship for the [MBAA Brewing and Malting Science Course and the Brewery Packaging Technology Course](#), both of which take place at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. The district will take and review applications, and award a scholarship to the program.

Criteria for eligibility:

1. Applicant must be a current member of the MBAA District Philadelphia and have been a member of the district for the last two consecutive years.
2. Applicant must possess a minimum of two (2) years service in the brewing industry.
3. Applicant must complete the application form, and obtain the endorsement of two Professional members of the MBAA.
4. Applicant must be able to attend the course for the designated application
5. Applications should be submitted no later than: 1/13/2014 for the [Brewery Packaging Technology Course](#) taking place on April 27 – May 8 2014.
6. Applications will be reviewed by the District Philadelphia Scholarship Committee (or officers if no committee exists) and a recipient will be announced
7. Scholarship covers the cost of the program, which includes tuition, materials, room and some board. It does not cover the cost of travel to the program
8. Recipients will be required to present a report to the district at a meeting describing their experience with the program.
