- Applications will be screened by the scholarship committee, and a winner chosen based on:

- Individuals who are likely to teach others.
- The scholarship committee reserves the right to withhold awarding of a scholarship for a given course in a given year if no suitable candidate is found.
- Decisions will be by vote of a simple majority and all decisions will be final. Committee members shall be ineligible to vote regarding scholarships for themselves or members of their families.
- Proof will be confirmed by the District that winners are in good standing with two-year tenure in the MBAA.
- Applicants must be committed to financing all other ancillary costs, including transportation, involved with the course.
- Any misrepresentation on an application or supporting documentation will disqualify the applicant from receiving scholarship funds.
- Scholarship will be marketed through the MBAA website, district email list, and the MBAA forum.
