Membership Chair, Duties and responsibilities

The District President is the presiding Chair of the District Executive Board and is duly elected by the Executive Board.

 - Work with the Exec Committee in providing ideas and time to further bring value and interest to the organization as the members' needs change.
- Support new members and visitors by introducing them to the organization at their first meeting.
