- Scholarships are available to District MI members in good standing who have both been an MBAA member for at least one (1) full year and who currently live in the district.
- The scholarships are awarded annually and cover the entire tuition for either one of the MBAA Full Courses (Packaging Technology; Brewery Maintenance Systems; or Brewing and Malting Science).
- After attending a course, recipients should be prepared to explain to the membership body how they benefited from the scholarship. This will ideally be done in person at the District Michigan meeting immediately following the end of the course or, if necessary, in writing.
- Scholarships will not be awarded to the same person two years in a row.
