

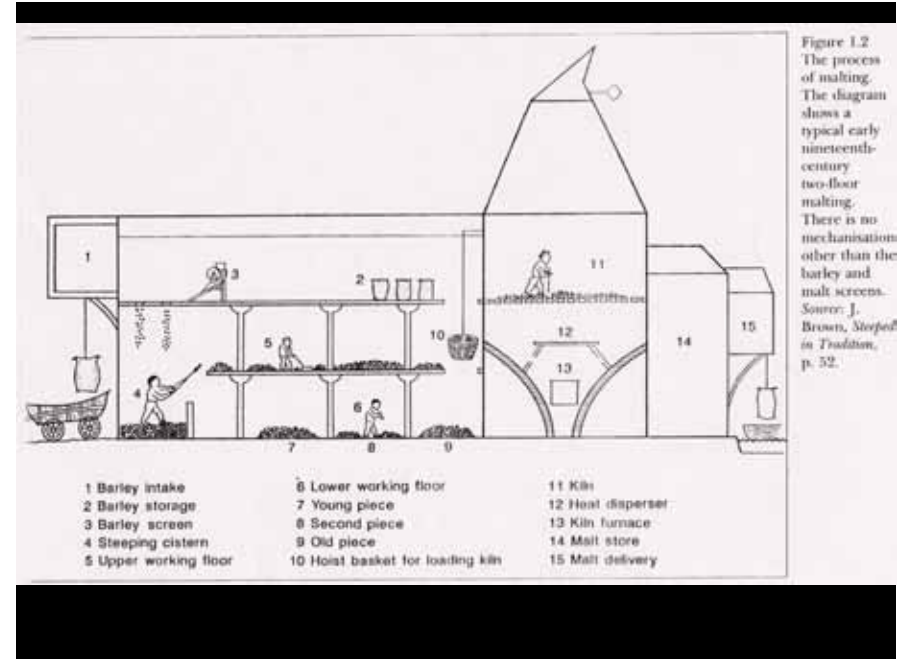


Alaskan Smoked Porter
