## Brewers in Canada

CLASSIFIED BY PROVINCES AND TOWNS.

Note.—Since the war began all provinces of the Dominion of Canada have adopted prohibition measures. However, in the majority of the provinces, beer containing not more than 2½ per cent Canadian proof spirit, which is about 1¼ per cent alcohol by weight—so called "temperance beer"—is not affected by the laws. Personal use of intoxicating beverages has not yet been prohibited, if same are imported from another province of Canada.

On December 22, 1917, the Dominion Government passed an act prohibiting the importation into Canada of any liquor containing over 2½ per cent proof spirits, and have announced that after the first of April, 1918, no liquor may be manufactured in Canada containing over 2½ per cent proof spirits, nor will it be legal to ship into any dry province after April 1, 1918, any liquor containing over 2½ per cent proof spirits. The manufacture of spirits for beverage purposes was discontinued November 1, 1917.
