District Governor report (Mike Scanzello):

- Gave recap of TQ-in-print issue:
 - o Pushing for retiree access to TQ online.
 - o Will email Jim D. to put on docket for Providence meeting.
 - Needs to be put before Executive Board before General Board.
 - o Mike Sutton's cost analysis of nixing the printed TQ to be published in Communicator.
 - Was told that "We cannot provide TQ online at no cost". Retirees would need to pay for membership to receive online access.
 - Joe Thorner suggested that the question be asked: "If nixing printed TQ saves money, why didn't fees go down?". Essentially, we are asking for justification of online 'cost'.
 - Mike will bring this up at the June BOG meeting; during Old Business.
 - Jerry Hilton & Bill Ladish noted that for decades, there used to be a one-time fee for retirees.
