Brewery Water Savings Systems... presented by Alfa Laval

Breweries often use sprayballs for robust cleaning application, but direct impingement devices offer significant water savings. An authoritative presentation with plant data offers a good starting place for exploring water consumption optimization. Beyond water savings, there is great opportunity for cycle time reduction.

Maximum Efficiency in Today's Boilers...presented by Miura Boiler

With a focus to reduce NOx emissions to the lowest levels in history, engineering design and specification for the brewery support the reality of maximizing steam output for fuel input at the greatest efficiency. What makes a modern boiler efficient, and trends in boiler feedstocks such as biogas and water chemistries will be discussed by one of the largest boiler engineering and fabrication company known in the US.

Greatest energy conservation in the brewhouse... presented by Pursuit Dynamics

The brewhouse consumes approximately 50% of the steam in any brewery, and the kettle represents a large part of that energy consumption. The PDX design approach is presented which is scalable from artisanal brewery scale to major brewhouse scale. The advantage of deploying such a novel engineered system for the smaller brewery is that it changes the economics of energy recovery. A smaller brewhouse might not be able to justify vapor recovery systems, but if the approach is to cut the steam use at kettle by 50%, one key piece of hardware provides the savings that otherwise require additional component design, purchase and installation.
